Recital Policies

Since dance is a performance art, participation in our annual recital is recommended however, it is not mandatory. Your child will not be left out of any portion of his/her class if he/she decides not to participate this year.

RECITAL FEE:

LeRoux School of Dance established a recital fee in lieu of an annual advertising drive. The funds raised by their recital fee help with the costs of production of the recital, as well as giving the opportunity to provide additional recital services to our families at a discounted rate. Recital fees cover production costs and provide our families with the following recital services at a discount: Recital music edited for rehearsal outside of class time, Professional DVD of the recital which includes our Photo Montage, a recital t-shirt displaying our theme and artwork, one Photo Memory Mate (class photo & individual portrait) complete with recital theme and artwork, AND 4 tickets to the recital. Deposit of recital fees is due in October, with balance due in March.

RECITAL COSTUMES:

Our costume order and authorization form must be completed and returned with a costume deposit in November. The number of costumes required will be indicated on the order form. **All costume balances are due in January.**

RECITAL ELIGIBILITY:

- All students enrolled in Children's Dance 1 through Advance are eligible to perform in the recital.
- Students usually participate in 1 dance for each style of dance they take (ballet, tap, jazz, etc.).
- Certain classes and/or students will only be in 1 dance, either due to their beginner level or due to the number of classes they attend each week. You will be notified when this occurs.
- Students who join after December 1st must have teacher approval before electing to participate in the recital.

RECITAL FINANCIAL COMMITMENT:

- Students are required to pay a Recital Fee. \$125.00 for first dancer; Sibling fee: \$25.00 each
- Students are required to purchase costumes for each dance. Estimated pricing is below.
- Students may choose not to participate in all dances with their class; however *only tap and jazz are optional*. This decision should be discussed with your teacher.
- Costume Fees are as follows:

Child Costumes (sizes small, intermediate or medium)	\$48.00 each
Child Costumes (size large)	\$50.00 each
Child 2-in-1 Costumes (size small, intermediate or medium)	\$80.00 **
Child 2-in-1 Costumes (size large)	\$85.00 **
Child XL & Adult Costume (child ex-large, adult small, medium & large)	\$62.00 each
Adult XL or Adult XXL (size 16A – 18A)	\$70.00 each
- 2-in-1 Costume Description: The same bodysuit for two dances, accessorized differently for each number (tutu, skirt, pants, headpieces, etc).
- Admission fees for the recital are as follows:

Adult Tickets	\$15.00 each
Child Ticket (under 12)	\$10.00 each
- Seating assignment is done by lottery. Ask for more details if this is your first recital.
- Due to fire code requirements a ticket must be purchased for each person, regardless of age.

RECITAL DATES & LOCATION:

- Recital will be held at Spring-Ford 9th Grade Center on Sunday, June 6th.
- Dress Rehearsal will be mandatory, on Friday, June 4th.
- Rehearsal and Recital times will be provided with the February issue of Footnotes.
- Parents or any other visitors are not permitted at rehearsals or in the dressing room at the recital. Students are well taken care of at all times by experienced staff.
