Student & Studio Policies 2010-11

Whether or not students are planning a professional dance career, good discipline, working toward a goal and learning to accept challenges and disappointment are lessons needed for life. In order to maintain a high level of training and discipline for our dancers, we need everyone's cooperation. Even our youngest dancers benefit from a structured environment that is filled with dance and music, and of course, lots of FUN!

LOBBY ETIQUETTE:

So that our dancers can enter the classroom in a calm and orderly fashion we ask that they sit quietly on our lobby benches when waiting for class to begin.

In keeping Safety First, we ask that you help us prevent injury by not allowing your children to sit on our reception wall, walk or stand on our benches, or run anywhere in our facility.

To avoid disruption or distraction of the students in class, please refrain from banging or knocking on classroom doors, walls or windows and remember to use your 'inside voice' at all times.

Food and drink is not permitted in the lobby. Please use our party room and dispose of trash properly.

Families who stay in the lobby are welcome to use our TV/VCR/DVD or WIFI during class time. Please ask for assistance. All coloring, games or other activities should be played in the party room.

Families are welcome to 'peek in' to our classrooms occasionally, but are reminded that fire codes require the hall be kept clear from the front lobby to the rear exit of the facility.

ADMINISTRATIVE POLICIES:

All communication from the studio is provided via email and is displayed on both bulletin boards in our lobby area; it is also accessible at our website www.lerouxdance.com.

So that our classes can begin on time, please leave a message with the administrative staff if you need to discuss a topic with your child's teacher. She will be happy to contact you at the end of her shift.

Tuition is due on the first of every month. Invoices are not provided. Those who have not chosen our Autopay program must make all payments by cash or check. Payment envelopes will be provided.

Account questions should be directed to administrative staff only.

Late fees apply to all payments not received by their respective due dates.

DRESS CODE:

Dancers work harder and stay more focused when they are properly dressed for class.

Students must arrive in uniform for each class. We do not have a private dressing area. Students who are consistently out of uniform or come for class without proper shoes may not be allowed to participate in class.

Please wear appropriate 'cover-ups' when arriving and leaving the studio. Teen & pre-teen dancers must have undergarments covered at all times. If you need assistance finding proper undergarments for wear under a bodysuit please speak with our director.

Hair must be in a ponytail or bun for every class. If hair is short, it must be pulled back off the face with barrettes or a headband.

For the safety of the students, jewelry may not be worn during class.

All ballet slippers must be secured with elastic (elastic must be sewn appropriately on shoes, not tied). Strings must be tied, trimmed and tucked in or removed from ballet slippers.

Girl's tie tap shoes must be secured with elastic and ribbons discarded. No tap buttons, please. LeRoux will provide tap shoe elastic to all students with tie shoes.

Dress Code 2010-11

Dancers work harder and stay more focused when appropriately dressed for class.

Petite Feet 1 & 2	Petite Feet T-shirt and black leggings, dance pants or shorts. Bare feet or socks with treads. Parents should dress comfortably for Petite Feet 1 class, as they will be actively participating.
Pre-Ballet	Pink bodysuit*, white footless tights and white ballet slippers.
Pre-Ballet/Tap	Pink bodysuit*, white footless tights and white ballet slippers. When tap is added, students will need tan tap shoes and footed tights or socks.
Children's Dance Level 1 & Level 2	Pink bodysuit*, white tights, white ballet slippers and tan tap shoes.
Children's Dance Level 2-3	Pink bodysuit*, white tights, white split-sole ballet slippers and tan tap shoes. Although growth can be considered in the fall ballet slippers should begin to be worn tighter for proper training.
Children's Dance Level 3, Level 3-4 & Level 4 Mini Steppers Dance Team	Black bodysuit*, white tights; white split-sole ballet slippers, tan tap shoes and black jazz boots. This level requires hair to be off neck and face for every class, bun is requested. Although growth can be considered in the fall ballet slippers should begin to be worn tighter for proper training.
Intermediate Level Ballet & Lyrical Jr. Steppers Dance Team	Black bodysuit*, pink tights and snug fitting, pink split-sole ballet slippers. This level requires hair to be off neck and face, in a bun for every class. Friday lyrical class as shoe requirement - please speak with Miss Wendi for specific style number. Absolutely no bare legs, sweats, gym shorts, tank tops or t-shirts. Skirts and/or 'boy shorts' may be permitted at sole discretion of the instructor.
Advanced Level Ballet & Lyrical Sr. Steppers Dance Team	Black bodysuit*, pink tights and snug fitting, pink split-sole ballet slippers. This level requires hair to be off neck and face, in a bun for every class. Monday lyrical class is required to have bare feet. Absolutely no bare legs, sweats, gym shorts, tank tops or t-shirts. Skirts and/or 'boy shorts' may be permitted at sole discretion of the instructor.
Boys Attire	Tight fitting tank or tee-shirt and black shorts or dance pants (dancer will be too hot for sweatpants). Black socks (no sweat socks). Shoes: Black ballet slippers, black tap shoes, black jazz oxford, and black dance sneakers.
Cheer	Pink bodysuit*, black shorts or skort with white tights and white ballet slippers.
Hip-Hop	Tight fitting LeRoux tank or black bodysuit* with black dance pants and black dance sneakers. Pants may not be longer than dancer's leg - meaning, pants must sit on top of shoe or be a Capri style. Absolutely no outside sneakers are to be worn in our classrooms.
All Intermediate, Advanced & Team Level Tap/Jazz Rhythm Tap	Black bodysuit* with pink or tan tights. This level requires hair to be off neck and face, bun is preferred. Absolutely no bare stomach or legs; no sweats, gym shorts, layered tank tops or t-shirts. Tight, black 'boy shorts' may be permitted at sole discretion of the instructor. Shoes for Tap: Tan 1 ½" heeled character tap shoe and/or Black flat tap boot Shoes for Jazz: Black jazz boot
Musical Theatre Dance	Black bodysuit* and white, pink or tan tights with black jazz boot. Tight, black 'boy shorts' may be permitted at sole discretion of the instructor. Absolutely no bare legs, sweats or t-shirts.

bodysuit* = Bodysuits with LeRoux logo are required for most classes and are sold only at LeRoux.

GENERAL STUDIO POLICIES:

Students are not permitted to leave the waiting area without an adult or guardian. Administrative staff is not responsible for students. Please be on time and escort your child in and out of the studio.

Students should visit the bathroom before their class begins. Bathroom visits during class are discouraged, as they are a disruption to the entire class. Personal concerns should be discussed with your instructor.

Students should attend all scheduled classes, be on time and prepared. Intermediate and advanced students arriving more than 15 minutes late may not be permitted to participate in class for their own safety. This decision is made at the sole discretion of the instructor.

Students who are not well enough to fully participate in their class must bring a note explaining their limitations. Without a note, they will be required to participate fully or they will be dismissed from class.

Students who attend a class that is a minimum of 1 ½ hour in length are permitted to bring or purchase a water bottle. Absolutely no other beverages are permitted. *No water bottles are permitted in any class less than 1 ½ hour in length.*

Tap shoes are not permitted outside of the classroom.

Cell phones and texting tools are not permitted in our classrooms at any time.

Visitors (children or adults) are not permitted in class at any time, except on designated days.

Body Art (piercings/tattoos) must be removed or covered while taking class or representing the studio at rehearsal, performance, competition or field trip of any kind.

Photographs taken during performances or class may be used for promotion or display. Photos may also be posted on a social networking website that is accessible only to those approved by LeRoux School of Dance.

The Golden Rule is followed at all times by staff and students: *Do unto others as you'd have done to you.*
